PRODUCT OVERVIEW

With black and white print speeds as fast as 16 ppm for A4-size pages, the Phaser 6110 can support your daily business while also providing convenient colour printing capabilities when you need them. The combination of print speed, professional print quality of up to 2400 dpi enhanced resolution and low starting price make the Phaser 6110 a high-value solution for small business.

Size and Features that Fit

If you work in a small business, odds are that you work in an office where space is limited. The technology that you choose to bring into your office needs to be smartly designed and space efficient. The Phaser 6110 has a small footprint with dimensions of 390 mm wide by 344 mm deep by 265 mm high, and is lightweight at just 13.6 kg. Quiet operation, even when printing, makes the Phaser 6110 a strong choice for small offices.

Section 2

Evaluating Colour Laser Printers

EVALUATION CRITERIA

Entry-level colour laser printers must excel in a few key areas to successfully meet the needs of small business/small office environments. The printer must be able to support the day to day operations of the office, meaning that despite the affordable purchase price the printer must feature performance to support one to five busy professionals. The printer must deliver this value in a small package – to comfortably fit in your office without requiring extra space. The printer also has to be user friendly and easy to use – most small businesses do not have IT resources at their disposal, meaning employees must be able to keep the printer running without becoming technical experts.

This section of the Evaluator Guide will look at each of these areas, and suggest ways you can evaluate printers against these requirements. Do this for all the colour laser printers you are considering and you'll see how the Phaser 6110 exceeds expectations on all counts.

Does the combination of entry level price and performance meet the needs of your small business? Will the black and white print quality meet your day to day printing needs, and does the colour print quality give your company the professional appearance you need to present your clients? Does the printer deliver advanced printing features to increase your productivity, and include media support you need to run your business?

HOW THE PHASER 6110 EXCEEDS THE VALUE REQUIREMENT:

PERFORMANCE

The Phaser 6110 is capable of supporting your day to day black and white printing requirements with up to 16 ppm printing speed for A4-sized black and white documents. Suitable for occasional colour printing, the Phaser 6110 brings convenient colour printing into your office with up to 4 ppm colour printing speed. The 300 MHz processor and standard 32 MB of memory in the Phaser 6110 contribute to the 14 second black and white / 26 second colour first-page-out-times, and enable the Phaser 6110 to adeptly handle busy print queues and complex print jobs.

PRINT QUALITY

With print resolution starting at 600 x 600 dpi and going up to 2400 x 600 dpi enhanced, the Phaser 6110 is capable of delivering the print quality you need to support the professional image of your business.

The printer has a single paper tray that holds up to 150 sheets of paper, with support for:

- Paper Size – Supported sizes include A4, letter, legal, folio, oficio, executive, ISO B5, JIS B5, and custom sizes ranging from 76 x 127 mm to 216 x 356 mm.
- Paper Weight – Supported weights ranging from 60 to 163 gsm.
- Paper Types – Supported media types include plain paper, envelopes, labels, transparencies, and card stock.

SMALL COMPACT DESIGN

At just 390 mm wide, 344 mm deep and 265 mm high – the Phaser 6110 has the smallest footprint in its class and is a great option for space-constrained office environments. At 13.6 kg, it is also the lightest printer in its class. This adds up to make the Phaser 6110 a printer that can be easily deployed onto a desktop for an individual user, or onto a tabletop as a shared printer for multiple users.

SMALL OFFICE READY

Being small office ready isn’t just about having a small, lightweight form-factor – other factors include noise-levels generated by the printer and how supplies are accessed and replaced. The Phaser 6110 generates less than 5.6 (B) L_{WA} when printing and less than 3.5 (B) L_{WA} when in standby mode – among the lowest noise levels in its class. The commonly replaced consumables of the Phaser 6110 – including toner cartridges, waste toner cartridge and paper – are accessed via the front of the printer, making supplies easy to replace without needing to move the printer.



CONNECTIVITY OPTIONS

The Phaser 6110 offers you two configuration options, giving you the option of having USB 2.0 connectivity to a single computer or having built-in 10/100 BaseTX Ethernet connectivity for shared printing over your network.

EVALUATE USER FRIENDLINESS

Printers designed for small businesses must be easy enough for non-technical employees to set-up and install. Further, because most small and medium-sized business have limited or no IT support, printers deployed into their offices must be easy to use and simple to manage on an ongoing basis.

EASY TO SETUP AND INSTALL

At just 13.6 kg, the Phaser 6110 is light enough for an individual to unpack the printer and place it into its location in your office. Once the printer is in place, plug in the power and connectivity cables and turn on the printer. Using the included installation CD you will be able to install driver software for your Phaser 6110 onto your computer in as few as four clicks – getting you up and running quickly and easily.
